Notes and Reminders

- During the month of September all Young students will participate in Curriculum Based Measurements in the area of reading and math. There is no student preparation that is needed. Teachers use this information to help plan for instruction as well as to monitor student growth over the course of the school year.
- **Kids Marathon (Team Young)--Deadline September 7**
 - Students ages 5 to 13 can sign-up to be part of Team IPEF and run a marathon this fall as part of a unique fitness program sponsored by the Naperville Marathon. The program is a great way for kids to get fit, learn about fitness goals and see how much fun running can be. Students run 25 miles (one mile at a time) during the next eight weeks and track their miles. On October 22, they get to run the final mile on a portion of the Naperville Marathon course, receiving a finisher medal and t-shirt.
 - The cost to participate is \$36, which includes a donation to our school and a Team IPEF t-shirt. The registration deadline is September 7.
