Currently, Young School has 20 out of 27 classrooms air conditioned. The classrooms without air conditioning are assigned to a partner air conditioned room to rotate in and out of the air conditioned locations throughout the course of the day to help students stay cool.

Next Monday and Tuesday are predicted to be in the high 80s. Please dress your child in clothing that helps him or her to stay cool and send them to school with a water bottle.
